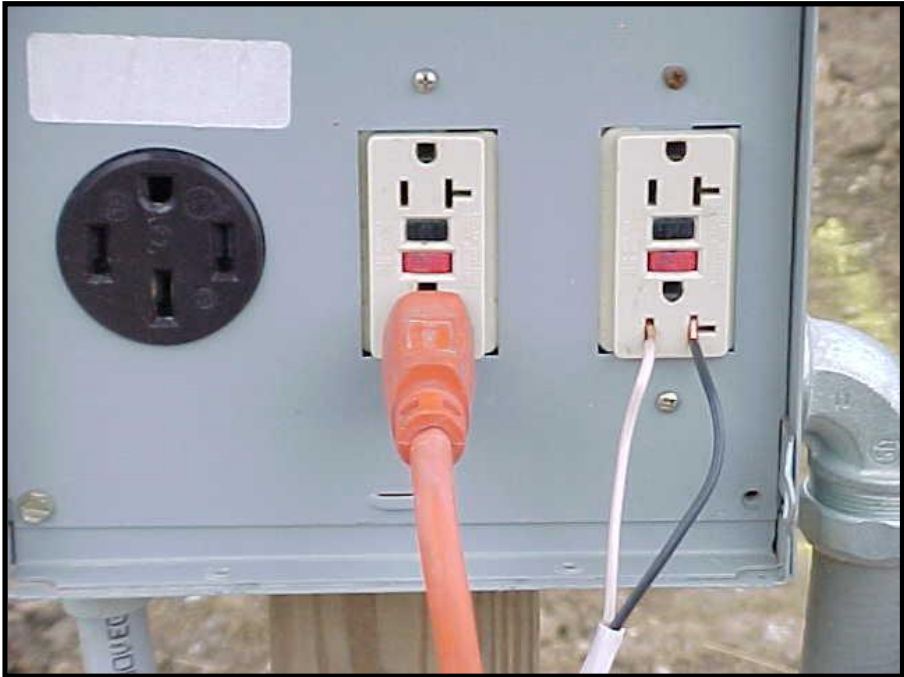


# Tool Box Meeting

## Electrical Safety – Extension Cords



Electrocution is one of the leading causes of death in construction. Extension cords used on construction sites must be inspected before each use and used in the manner for which they were intended. Cords and tools should be plugged into GFCI protected receptacles to help prevent shock or electrocution.
