

Tool Box Meeting Scaffolds – Fall Protection



Falls kill more construction workers each year than any other single hazard. One of the hazards when working from scaffolds is falling off or through the scaffold. OSHA requires that a competent person supervise the erection or all scaffolds, and that workers using the scaffold be properly trained on scaffold hazards.
